# What is YouRock?

YouRock is a **free, multi-language, employability networking tool** designed for young people and employers across Europe.

It helps **employers** to:

- Identify proactive new employees with specific skills
- See international candidates in any of the system languages

It helps **young people** to:

- Identify their professional work skills
- Build a dynamic profile showing their primary skill groups
- Create a portfolio of online content showing their skills



# The Employer Search

Employers do not need to register on the website to search and view user profiles.

Simply start typing key words in the white search field or press the **Search** button to go to the Search page.

# The User Profile

The user profile displays the user skills in a 'diamond' graphic that shows their strongest skill group as the largest segment.

By clicking on each segment title the list of corresponding skills are displayed below.

All individual skills can be viewed as a list where any endorsements are shown.

A traditional **Resume** displays employment, education and qualifications, as well as specific ICT skills and spoken languages.

Finally, a **Portfolio** of links to online content can show further evidence of the skills of users.

# Multi-lingual profiles

User profiles are displayed in the language of the visitor, irrespective of the original language of the profile. This supports cross border recruitment and identifying users with international transferable skills.

The system languages are English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Greek, Polish, Dutch, Russian, Romanian, Lithuanian, Serbian, Croatian, Hungarian, Bulgarian, Latvian and Catalan

Further languages are in development.
